Lightfoot, Micaela Thorpe appeals the District Court s denial of her petition to have her young son returned to Trinidad after he was abducted to the US by his father, Antoine Lightfoot, in violation of the Hague Convention on International Child Abductions. This appeal raises three issues of public international law and international family law, specifically: Does a US court have jurisdiction over an anticipatory breach, given the conflicting international law on this issue? Would it pose a grave risk of harm to return a child suffering from PTSD to the place where his PTSD-triggering injuries occurred? Is an 8-year-old child sufficiently mature for a court to consider his objections when repatriating him against his will? This case file is intended for two audiences. First, it is intended for professors of international or family law, allowing them to assign any or all of the documents in the file as practice materials to supplement students training in the substantive law.
